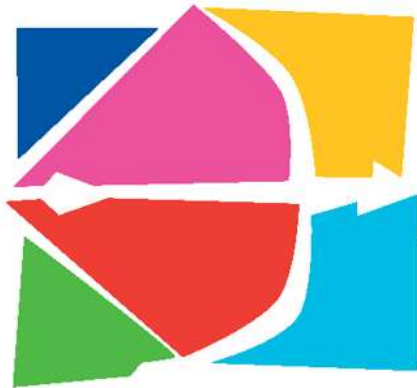

Three Steps To Certification;

1. Application and Pre-Course Assignment.
2. Certification Course
3. Post Course Assignments.

World Archery Americas Application and Pre-Course Assignment

- Active in Nationally Recognized Program
- Coaches should be able to verify they have coached archers in a national or international tournament.
- Coaches should also be able to provide a one page summary of their recent archery experience and relevant continuing education over the past two years.

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Application and Pre-Course Assignment

- How have they used this experience and education to improve their archer's/team skill level and tournament performance This should be performance related information.
- A coach should be able to document the coach's future realistic goals. Are the coaches goals set by their federation?
- What are their federation's goals for the next two years?
- And what development plans are in place to achieve these goals.
- How will they track and measure their progress?

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Application and Pre-Course Assignment

- Is there a coach mentor program? How does the mentor program help the development of coaches and archers?

World Archery Americas Certification Course

- Allow course instructors the academic freedom to structure the course material to the class being taught
- The course will follow the published outline of World Archery's Level 1 and Level 2 coaches' manuals.
- No two classes will be exactly the same.
- Allows the instructor to identify coaches who are pursuing Recreational instructor certification and those who are High Performance coach certification.

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Post Course Assignment

- Is intended to draw on the contents of the course materials along with the pre-course assignment.
- Since no two coaches are the same, no two post course assignment should be the same.
- Instructional material should be structured consistent with the coaches' and countries goals , objectives and development plan.
- The Post Course Assignment will have a time limit to complete. It will include tasks to be completed along with measurable performance indicators.
- Post Course Assignment includes working with a Higher Level Mentor Coach to complete the course assignment and certification process.
