- PARTICIPANTS:** **One representative from each National Olympic Committee member of PASO**
- REQUIREMENTS:**
- To be a High Performance Coach.
  - To be proposed by his / her National Olympic Committee.
  - Studies of medium or high level Education.
  - To have at least 4 years experience working with High Performance Athletes.
  - Presentation of Health Certificate.

**We remind you that under the new guidelines issued by the National Migration Institute (Mexico), the interested party must apply for the visa in person at any Mexican Consular office in his / her own country; this is because after November 8, 2012, the Internment Permits which were processed by the Mexican Olympic Committee have been suspended.**

**ENTRIES:** On the official entry form, which should be sent to the Mexican Olympic Committee by the NOC representing the Coach, confirming the participation and accompanied by a brief curriculum of the entered individual.

**THE ENTRY FORM MUST BE SENT BEFORE THE DEADLINE OF TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 09, 2014.**

**DYNAMICS OF THE COURSE:** THEORETICAL – PRACTICAL

**LENGTH:** 5 days according to the calendar planned, plus the arrival and departure dates.

**GENERAL TOPICS:**  
a) Technical – Methodological 70%  
b) Sports Sciences 30%

**LECTURER OF THE COURSE:** To be determined.

**CURRICULAR LOAD:** A 5-day Course with 40 hours of Classes

**ORGANIZATION:**  
2 daily Sessions  
- Morning  
- Afternoon

**EVALUATION:** Corroboration of acquired knowledge.

**CERTIFICATION:** Diploma of the course signed by the President of PASO, the President of the NOC and the Lecturer.

**REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTIFICATION:**

- 90% of attendance in the Course.
- Dynamic participation during the class sessions.
- To comply with the test exercises conducted.
