**Minimum Standard Criteria (MSC)** includes, and not limited to the following:

1. Minimum Standard Criteria (MSC)

1. Free access for all athletes and their sports equipment into the country
2. WA rules for Anti-doping including testing
3. Minimum of 2 (two) WA International or Continental Judges appointed
4. Technical Delegate (TD) inspection and review
5. The Organizer has to provide for each archer, the following information in order to ensure no duplicate information on archers in the database:
  - ID Number
  - Name ( Family Name, First Name)
  - Category
  - Date of Birth ( DD/MMM/YYYY)
  - Member Association (MA) Acronym
6. Results in WA required format agreed and supervised by a nominated official at the event. The results must be sent to the WA/WAA and TO2015 Offices no later than one (1) week after the tournament in hard copy and/or electronic copy as required by WA/WAA and TO2015



2. Submission of WRT for Sanction by WA

1. MAs will apply for WRT status via their respective CA on the appropriate form. No other form of application will be accepted.
2. The CA will then submit the event to the WA Office.
3. The WA Office will review and approve or decline the CA WRT application

**Notes:**

1. It is recommended **but not mandatory** that the tournament include a WA Certified Event Organizer. Or an equivalent experienced Technical Delegate or Tournament Director.
2. It is recommended **but not mandatory**, that the Chairman of the Tournament Judge Commission is not from the host MA. The remainder of the Tournament Judge Commission can be National, Continental or International Judges from the applying MA upon the approval of WAA. Appointments from outside the MA will be arranged by the CA in liaison with the FITA Judge Committee.
3. It is recommended **but not mandatory** that a TD be appointed. The CA bears the costs for the preliminary and subsequent visits by the TD or the Organizer appoints and bears the expense if the CA declines.
4. No costs can be set against WA and WAA without their consent.
5. It is recommended that the program used for the results system will be the official WA Results program provides (Tfors and IANSEO). If another program is used it will have to comply with FITA and Olympic Results and Information Services (O.R.I.S.) standard.

We agree to comply with the Minimum Stand Criteria (MSC) and will supply the results to the WA, WAA and TO2015 offices in the agreed deadlines and correct format. By Tfors or IANSEO or other WA/WAA prior approved source. We agree to host and fund the tournament in the spirit of service to the archers, competition and sport.
