Item 1. Mrs. Gloria Rosa, WAA President, congratulates all candidates from the Americas who were elected to positions in WA at Congress today.

Item 2. Seminar for coaches' trainers. Mr. Sr. Sergio Font, Sec. Gral, explains that coordinations have been made with Pascal Colmaire to conduct a coaches' trainers' seminar in Santiago de Chile on February 6-16, 2014. Each country can send one coach with qualification equal to or higher than Level II (or with at least two years' experience) and professional skills allowing him/her to teach in order to train coaches. The seminar will be conducted by Pascal Colmaire (WA) and Martin Frederick (German coach working for the Chilean Federation).

Accommodation and meals will be covered by Olympic Solidarity via World Archery. Sergio Font explains that Gloria Rosa will meet with PASO in Toronto at the beginning of October with the intention to get additional funding that would allow covering travelling expenses of the participants.

The Sec. Gral informs that the qualification round for recurve archery will be shot as follows:

- Mexican Grand Prix, Xalapa, Mexico (April 22-28) 1440 Round
- World Ranking Event, Guatemala (May 26 – June 1) 1440 Round
- Copa Juan Enrique Barrios, Puerto Rico (June 22-26) 1440 Round
- World Cup, Medellín (July 1-6) 70 m Round
- Pan American Olympic Festival (July 17-19) 70 m Round
- Pan American Championships, Rosario, Argentina (Oct. 18-25) 70 m Round
- Central American and Caribbean Games, Veracruz (Nov. 16-23) 1440 Round
