



2016 MICA/CIMA REPORT

For 2016, we had 3081 individual participants, our largest ever! This up from 2790 in '15 and '14 (2613), formerly our largest ever. We also had 173 teams up from 167 last year, and only 7 less than highest last year of 180. The total number of countries was 13 very close to our best ever at 14 last year, with 11 in '14, 10 in '13, and 11 in '12. The following table outlines the participation for the past 6 years.

This was the second year for para categories, we hope t will grow in the future!
